## Directions

Read the following scenarios and follow the one that is right for you:

**Option 1:** If you need to change your career goal, and if you **don't** know what the goal should be, return to Task 2 CS5 (Identify Possible Career Options) and select a more appropriate occupation, and continue the program from that point. ***Good luck in your new career!***

**Option 2:** If you need to change your career goal, and if you **know** what the goal should be, return to Task 6 CS13 (Define a Tentative Career Mission) and define what your objective will be in your new career, and then continue the program from that point. ***Good luck in your new career!***

**Option 3:** If you do not wish to change your career goal, but need to change your mission, return to Task 6 CS14 (Define a Tentative Career Mission) and rewrite your mission. Depending upon the change to your mission, you may or may not have to change your entrance qualifications to-do checklist. ***Good luck in your new career!***

**Option 4:** If you do not wish to change your career goal, but need to change your entrance qualifications to-do checklist, return to Task 7 CS15 and redefine your plan. ***Good luck in your new career!***
